KNIT-A-BIT

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Mesh Scarf with Edge Treatment

Size: Approximately 60 inches long and 7 inches wide

Materials: 1/2 ball of Marble Chunky Kurtzer (one ball 200 g, 341 yds), US 11 needles or size to achieve gauge. For other yarns use a needle one to two sizes bigger than recommended on the ball band.

Gauge: approximately 2.5 sts per inch and 3.5 rows per inch in Pattern Stitch.

Abbreviations:

sts = stitches

K = Knit

P = Purl

yo = yarn over

k2tog = knit 2 together

Pattern:

Row 1: *yo, k2tog*, repeat * to * over pattern sts.

Row 2: purl pattern sts.

Row 3: *k2tog, yo *, repeat * to * over pattern sts.

Row 4: purl pattern sts.

Edge Treatment: 3 stitches (pick one to do throughout)

Garter Edge

All rows: Slip as if to knit the first stitch, knit 2. (Do pattern sts.) Knit last 3 sts.

I-Cord Edge

Row 1 and all Odd rows: knit the 3 edge sts.

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Row 2 and all Even rows: slip, as if to purl, the 3 edge sts.

Scarf:

- 1. Cast-on 22 stitches (3 edge sts on each edge and 16 pattern sts).
- 2. For a Garter Edge: K3, purl to last 3 sts, K3. For an I-Cord Edge: Slip 3 sts, purl to last 3 sts, slip 3 sts.
- 3. Start with Pattern Row 1 keeping the 3 edge stitches in selected treatment.
- 4. Repeat Row 1 thru Row 4 for the pattern until the scarf is approximately 58 inches from the cast-on or until at least 1 foot of yarn remains (end with either Row 2 or 4).
- 5. Cast off.
- 6. Bury ends and block lightly.
