Nylon Pot Scrubber

J Crochet Hook

Cut nylon net in 2" strips (72" wide). 1 yd of netting makes 3 scrubbers.

Tie 6 strips together with square knots (I find it's better if you tie the strips together while you're doing the scrubber). **Work all single crochets in back loop.**

Chain 4 and connect with 2 single crochets (sc) in beginning loop. Single crochet twice in each stitch for 2 lengths of net. Single crochet once in each stitch until last length of net, then 4 more

Single crochet once in each stitch until last length of net, then 4 more stitches after knot.

Now decrease by doing a single crochet in every other stitch and finish by drawing through a loop to knot.

Stuff ends inside of ball and pull into shape.

Hints:

Use a rotary cutter to cut the netting. I fold it so that I have a 1 yd length of netting that's about 4" wide and then cut. If I'm going to do a lot of scrubbers, I usually work with about 5 yds of netting at a time and use a loose rubber band to hold each group of 6 strips.
